

Suggested enrichment activities –Spring 2 Year 6

English- can year 6 help the climate crisis

This term we have been learning about climate change and the impact it is having on people, the environment and animals.

To support your learning, you could:

- Research a climate activist group such as Extinction Rebellion or an individual such as Greta Thunberg. What are these people doing to support the cause? Do you agree or disagree with their actions? Can you suggest any better strategies to improve climate change awareness?
- Draw or make a diagram/model illustrating what the Greenhouse effect is.
- Write and/or illustrate a short story for children explaining what climate change is and what it is doing to our planet.

Topic- How have the rights of the child improved children's lives

We are exploring what life was like for children in the past. We are learning about how legislation such as the UN Declaration on the Rights of the Child have improved the well-being of children.

To support your learning, you could:

- Do some research to find out which individual people were most responsible for reforming children's rights e.g. Dr Bernado.
- Research Victorian life and living conditions. You could do a comparison to what life is like today, a poster, make a 3D model or think about children's life.
- Research parts of the world where children's rights are sadly not being respected. Present your findings however you like.

Topic- Electricity!

This term our science focus is Electricity!

To Support your learning, you could:

- Create a poster explaining how to stay safe around electricity.
- Research an individual associated with Electricity e.g. Edison, Tesla or Benjamin Franklin.
- Make a list of all the electrical items in your home. Think about how you could minimize electrical usage in your home.
